The Shiner's official philanthropy is Shriners Hospitals for Children, a network of 22 hospitals that provide, free of charge, expert specialized care to children under 18 years of age. WA WA Shriners are currently supporting 74 children from Saskatchewan who attend various Shriners Hospitals for Children. These trips, costing in excess of \$125,000.00 each year, are provided free of charge to the families through donations made by individual Shriners, Shrine Clubs and members of the public to the WA WA Shrine Patient Transportation Fund, a registered Canadian charity.
