

# WA WA ANNUAL PROVINCIAL GOLF TOURNAMENT

## RULES

1. Teams will be pre-determined, by the tournament committee, based on average scores supplied by the individual players on their entry form.
2. The tournament will be a slightly modified Las Vegas Scramble best ball format.
3. Each team will consist of four players. Each team will be supplied with a six sided die. Prior to the first tee off each team will assign a number from 2 to 5 to each of their players that will be retained by the respective player for the duration of the game. At each tee all four team members tee off then the die is rolled. If the number on the die is a 2, 3, 4 or 5 then the drive of the team member whose assigned number matches the number on the die must be used on that hole. Example: all four players tee off, then the die is rolled and shows a 4 then the drive of the designated player number 4 must be played on that hole. If the die shows a 1 then the shortest tee shot must be used on that hole. If the die shows a 6 any tee shot may be used. Subsequent shots following the tee shot may be determined by the team and played out as a normal scramble. Should a team have only three players the unused number shall rotate from player to player throughout the game. NOTE: THE DIE IS ROLLED ONLY AFTER EACH PLAYER HAS HIT THEIR TEE SHOT.

### Reverse Hole

For this hole only the die will not be rolled. All team members hit their tee shots. The tee shot farthest from the PIN is the ball that must be used for the second shot. All subsequent shots must use the ball farthest from the pin until the hole is complete.

The following holes will be designated for special prizes for both ladies' and men's:

- \*closest to the line
- \*longest putt
- \* closest to the pin

### Colored Ball

Each team will be given a colored ball at the start of the game to be hit in rotation by all members of the team until reaching the green. The rotation will continue at the next tee. At the end of the round, if the ball has not been lost, it is to be given to a committee member.

Following the game return all die's to a committee member.
